- 1) describe their contributions to the conception or design of the work; or the acquisition, analysis, or interpretation of data for the work,
- 2) describe their contribution to drafting the work or reviewing it critically for important intellectual content,
- 3) approve the version to be published,
- 4) be accountable for all aspects of the work in ensuring that questions related to the accuracy or integrity of any part of the work are appropriately investigated and resolved. A co-author should be able to identify which co-authors are responsible for specific other parts of the work. In addition, authors should have confidence in the integrity of the contributions of their co-authors.
